



## Speed dating with industry at NMC 2020

### *Invitation for companies*

*Would you like to speed date with PhD students and other participants at the Dutch Mathematical Congress NMC 2020, to share inspiration and ideas? The organising committee of NMC 2020 is inviting companies to participate in the NMC **Speed Dating Event**. The session will offer an invaluable opportunity to establish contacts between academia and industry.*

The speed dating session will be held during the first day of the congress, on **Tuesday April 14, 2020**. Companies can send up to two delegates, for example a researcher and an HR person. Topics to discuss are job opportunities and possible internships, and potential projects for cooperation. The speed dating is meant to provide an initial contact, which can be extended after the congress.

After compiling a list of companies interested, information will be posted on the conference website as well as directly to registered participants to inform them of the companies participating. It will be made clear that the speed dating is not only about job opportunities, but also about other ways of cooperating. For the companies, it provides also a way to obtain information on where to go if they have potential research questions suitable for internships and other projects.

Participants can indicate their preferences for the speed dating beforehand, and during the first day of the congress. A schedule will be made to enable as many discussions as possible, making the session optimally useful for both the companies and the participants.

The speed dating session will start with a short introduction, explaining the “rules of the game”. Companies are asked to bring a banner and present a 1 minute elevator pitch, so that participants know what the company stands and aims for. After this, the speed dating starts.
